In 1992 the then Dti suggested the creation of a broadly based trade body for the UK Safety Industry. Geoff was the author of the structure for this new trade body and brought together senior safety industry managers to assist its creation. Having persuaded them to invest in this project, Geoff was then asked to manage the newly formed British Safety Industry Federation in 1994, The initial structure of the BSIF set the model for the new concept of “lead trade bodies” providing an active link between government and industry sectors.

The Federation aims to support and represent suppliers of safety products and services across all aspects of safety legislation, standards making and major occupational safety issues. It enjoys active links with government departments and more than 120 representative trade bodies.
